Photo editing programs allow you to change the size of the image by adjusting the pixels, choosing the size you prefer, or reducing the photo by a certain percentage. Some programs have pre-installed settings for web photos or other standard configurations. You don't need to adjust the parameters of the photo, but it is an option. Save the photo file under a new name so you can easily identify a compressed photo file. Notice where you saved a new photo and close the program. Open the folder where the compressed file is stored. Most Windows computers save photo files in the Image folder by default, creating a slither for each date, event, or group of photos. Click the right button on the name of the image or sketch for a new file that needs to be zipped. Select Send and select a Compressed Folder on your computer using the Windows operating system. For example, a Word document (an extension of the .doc file), i.e. 65KB, can be reduced to 11KB after compression. You can use the basic file compression tool that is included in Windows, or you can download or purchase an alternative file compression tool. Go to the Word file you want to compress by selecting Documents in the Start menu to access My Documents or by selecting another folder that stores the .doc file. Select Send, and then select Compressed Folder. Windows automatically creates and saves a lightning folder containing a compressed file in the same folder as the original file. Notice the difference in file size. Double-click the folder to access the original file. If you want to send a compressed file as e-mail, select a zipped folder instead of the original file when attaching the file to the email. Download and install a free trial of the alternative file compression utility of your choice. Many file compression utilities have more features than the basic Windows utility, and they integrate into Windows and Mac systems. If you compress one item, the compressed file takes over the name of the original item, as well as the .zip extension. The first one is called Cyppto, but it's relatively easy to crack, at least according to info-SIP, which rated it pretty weak. The second is called the AES-256 route, which wasn't actually intended for email files - it's a strong encryption technique widely used across the board. A popular alternative to use, in any case is a 7-zip that is free and open source.
